The 2017 Ontario Summer Provincials and AA meet to be held from June 29 to July 2, 2017 at the Toronto Pan Am Sports Centre will be hosted by Swim Ontario with Central Region assisting in the delivery of the meet by organizing volunteers from their clubs.

The anticipated number of swimmers attending both meets will require the collaboration of many volunteers and officials. The AA meet (afternoon) is scheduled to be split into two pools, with racing taking part in the Competition Pool and Training Pool simultaneously. Though the bulk of volunteer help will come from Central Region, we will require the help from volunteers & officials from ALL regions to staff both the 2017 Summer Provincials and AA meet.
