ATHLETE PARTICIPATION FEE: \$400.00

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. Must be a Canadian Citizen or a Permanent Resident.
2. Must be eligible to represent Canada at major international games.
3. Must represent a Swim Ontario affiliated Club during domestic SNC National level competitions.
4. Must be fully registered, and in good standing with a Swim Ontario age group club and Swimming/Natation Canada during the event selection and delivery period.
5. Must qualify to swim at the TYR Pro-Series Santa Clara competition

PRIMARY ATHLETE SELECTION CRITERIA:

Only LC Olympic events will be considered for selection in priority order, to the long list, as follows:

1. TOP 50 IN THE FINA WORLD RANKINGS – [List published as of Sept 1, 2017](#)
2. 2018 COMMONWEALTH GAMES TEAM MEMBERS
3. GOLD Medalists at April 2018 Canadian swimming Championships - Montreal
4. SILVER Medalists at April 2018 Canadian swimming Championships - Montreal
5. BRONZE Medalists at April 2018 Canadian swimming Championships - Montreal
6. Swimmers NOT PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED from the above criteria who are nominated to the Jr Pan Pacific Team.
7. Any ties that occur as a result of this selection process will be broken by a comparative of world rank with the highest ranked swimmer awarded the spot.

PLEASE NOTE:

All SWIMMING CANADA High Performance Centre - ATHLETES are not eligible for selection to this tour team

ATHLETE SELECTION PROCESS:

1. Athletes will be ranked according to the prescribed selection criteria listed above.
2. A LONG LIST to a maximum of 12 athletes per gender meeting the above criteria will be produced by **FRIDAY April 20, 2018** and sent to the swimmers' coach of record.
3. Confirmation of ATHLETE participation must be received by Provincial Programs manager Darin Muma darin@swimontario.com by **FRIDAY April 27, 2018**.
4. Please note that athletes who **HAVE NOT CONFIRMED by APRIL 27 will be removed from the list** of eligible athletes.
5. **Final team list will be published on MONDAY APRIL 30TH, 2018.**
6. Final Team selection is at the discretion of the Performance Programs Manager.
7. Swim Ontario reserves the right, should circumstances dictate, to select an unequal number of male versus female swimmers.
8. Swim Ontario also reserves the right, should circumstances dictate, to NOT select a full complement of 12 swimmers.

This tour opportunity is made possible through Swim Ontario and the OHPSI Program to gain experience of racing elite senior international competition, to become more familiar with and comfortable around travelling as part of a provincial team to prepare for future national team selections.
