

**2017 Canada Summer Games – Team Ontario
Able-Bodied - Swimmer Nomination to the 2016-2017 Program**

Team Size: 16 Females and 16 Males
Performance Window: LCM Results from April 5, 2016 to August 7, 2016

Event Nomination: The 13 Olympic Events are eligible.

1. 50 Freestyle
2. 100 Freestyle
3. 100 Backstroke
4. 100 Breaststroke
5. 100 Butterfly
6. 200 Freestyle
7. 200 Backstroke
8. 200 Breaststroke
9. 200 Butterfly
10. 200 Individual Medley
11. 400 Individual Medley
12. 400 Freestyle
13. 800 Freestyle – Women or 1500 Freestyle - Men

Nomination Process/Criteria:

1. Nomination - Primary:

- **13 Females: All eligible swimmers shall be ranked based on their performances as a percentage of the Females 15 Year Old on track - Final Track time and selected in rank order until 13 different Females are nominated in each individual Olympic event.**
- **13 Males: All eligible swimmers shall be ranked based on their performances as a percentage of the Males 16 Year Old on track - Final Track time and selected in rank order until 13 different Males are nominated in each individual Olympic event.**
- **Tie Break:** Where there is a tie between two swimmers the next highest On Track ranked performance – as described above - in another event, for each swimmer, will be used. This process will used until the tie is broken.

2. Nomination – Secondary:

- **3 Females: All eligible swimmers, not already nominated under the Primary Nomination process, shall be ranked based on their performances as a percentage of the Females 15 Year Old on track - Final Track time and selected in rank order until 3 different Females are nominated.**
- **3 Males: All eligible swimmers, not already nominated under the Primary Nomination process, shall be ranked based on their performances as a percentage of the Males 16 Year Old on track - Final Track time and selected in rank order until 3 different Males are nominated.**
- **Tie Break:** Where there is a tie between two swimmers the next highest On Track ranked performance – as described above - in another event, for each swimmer, will be used. This process will used until the tie is broken.

2. General:

- **Year of Birth – Females: 2002 and younger; Males: 2001 and younger.**
- **SNC On Track Times – as published in the Fall of 2016 will be utilized as; Females 15 years old Final Track times and Males 16 years old Final Track times.**
- **Performances will be ranked as a percentage, to two decimal places, using On Track times as described above.**
- Performances from April 5, 2016 to August 7, 2016 are eligible.
- Performances done in individual Olympic events only, no relay lead-off or relay splits will be considered.
- To be eligible for nomination a swimmer must meet the Canada Summer Games eligibility criteria
