New Meet Sanction Process

The new SNC meet sanction and results site (www.swimmeet.ca) has been up and running for a couple weeks now and appears to be working quite well.

Reminders: The SNC site is for competitive swimmers only. Please continue to use the existing system through Swim Ontario for anything involving pre-competitive swimmers. If your previously sanctioned meet does not appear on the SNC site, you will be required to re-submit your application via the new system in order to have it appear on the calendar and allow you to upload your results. This should only affect a few clubs and will only take a few minutes of your time. In order for you to upload your results, you will be required to re-submit your sanction in it's entirety via the new swimmeet.ca process. We will do our best to ensure that you are fast-tracked through. This does not change the fact that you have already received your sanction, it is to enable you to upload your results.

With the implementation of the new Sanctioning process, we are pleased to announce that this will also create an automatic invoice for your gold bonus, tabulated from your posted results. This invoicing system has yet to be finalized, but the anticipated delivery is within the next two weeks. The new process will create invoices for all posted completed meets.

As of January 1, 2004, the federal government enforced the PIPEDA (Personal Information Protection & Electronic Documents Act) Policy. SNC, along with Swim Ontario has complied with this request.

These forms have been posted on our web site and Swim Ontario has requested these completed forms to be delivered, from each club, to the Swim Ontario office, for the past 3 years, by October 15th.
