Any of the funds that are collected cannot be disbursed or credited to an individuals account in any shape or form – funds raised must benefit of the entire club. Tax receipts are eligible for donations over \$10. If you club has a mandatory pre-set fundraising commitment, please ensure that any tax receipt requested by a parent is above the pre-set amount as set by the club.
