Please remember that only competitive sanction applications are to be submitted via the www.swimmeet.ca site and that all pre-competitive approval applications are to be handled as they have been in the past, through the Swim Ontario site. Any club hosting a meet that incorporates both competitive and pre-competitive swimmers must treat the events as two separate meets which requires two different, sanction and approval, submissions.
